

PARK & RIDE

There is no public car parking at the ground, the Club strongly recommends that you use one of the Park and Ride facilities that have been arranged with First, the University of the West of England (UWE) and Bristol City Council.

The Park and Rides will be based at UWE's Exhibition and Conference Centre and at the Bristol City Council park and ride facility on the A4 Portway, near Avonmouth (BS11 9QE). Buses will operate from 8.00am until 10.30am, and will operate for at least two hours after the match. Parking will be free and clearly signed from main routes into the city.

BY BUS

The Brightside Ground on Nevil Road is easily accessible by bus. Services 17, 70, 71, 73, 75/76, 78/79 run within a five minute walk of the main entrance using stops on the nearby Gloucester Road (Services 71, 73, 75/76, 78/79), Muller Road (Service 17) and Ashley Down Road (Service 70). All buses operate at very regular intervals, with services 70, 75 and 76 - even running 24 hours a day. See www.firstgroup.com/westofengland for fare information.
