

TRAVEL INFORMATION

PARK & RIDE

There is no public car parking at the ground, the Club strongly recommends that you use the Park and Ride facility that has been arranged with First and Bristol City Council.

The Park and Rides will be based at UWE's Exhibition and Conference Centre (BS34 8QZ), close to the M4/M32, and at the Bristol City Council Park and Ride facility on the A4 Portway, near Avonmouth (BS11 9QE). Buses will operate from 8.30am until 11am, and will operate for at least two hours after the match.

Parking will be free and clearly signed from main routes into the city. Park and Rides will operate earlier or later for the return, depending on when play finishes or the weather.

RETURN FARE TO THE BRIGHTSIDE GROUND, BRISTOL:

£5 per adult. Children 15 and under travel free of charge with a fare paying adult.

BY BUS

The Brightside Ground on Nevil Road is easily accessible by bus. Services 17, 70, 71, 73, 75/76, 78/79 run within a five minute walk of the main entrance using stops on the nearby Gloucester Road (Services 71, 73, 75/76, 78/79), Muller Road (Service 17) and Ashley Down Road (Service 70). All buses operate at very regular intervals, with services 70, 75 and 76 - even running 24 hours a day. See www.firstgroup.com/westofengland for fare information.

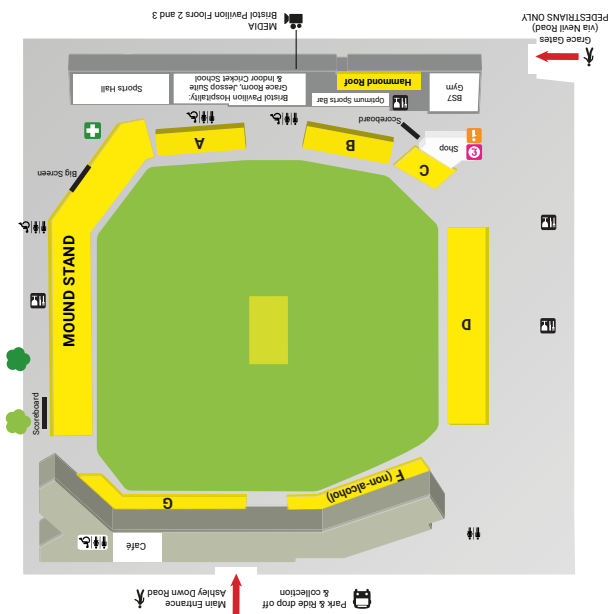

ADMISSION TO THE BRIGHTSIDE GROUND IS SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING:-

1. Due to ICC regulations all spectators and their bags will be searched on each occasion they enter the ground. (Please allow sufficient time to enter the ground.)
2. Please do not leave your bags unattended at any time.
3. Alcohol, metal cans or glass containers may not be brought into the ground at any time.
4. No musical instruments, large flags/banners, sticks, poles, knives or other similar sharp objects are allowed.
5. The consumption of alcohol is not permitted in Stand F.
6. Smoking is not permitted in any stand.
7. Please retain your match ticket at all times during the day. You must show your ticket to be admitted to the stand.
8. If you wish to leave the ground you must have your match ticket endorsed before leaving. Your match ticket must be presented at the turnstiles in order for you to be re-admitted.
9. Spectators who enter the playing area are liable to be arrested by the Police and face prosecution under the Public Order Act and/or be fined £1000 for Aggravated Trespass.
10. The use of threatening behaviour, foul or abusive language, indecent or racist chanting or comment will not be tolerated.
11. In the event of an emergency it may be necessary to evacuate the ground, please follow the directions of the stewards.
12. Should you require any help or assistance during your visit please contact the nearest steward.
13. Admittance to the venue is subject to ground regulations, a full copy can be obtained on request. Failure to comply with these regulations may result in ejection from the ground and possible further action.
14. Please note that due to space limitations all children, including babies, will require a ticket for this match.
